These resources will greatly enhance the school's digital infrastructure while ensuring a more comfortable and technology-enabled learning environment for students.

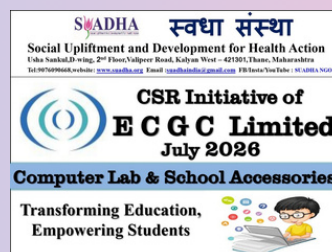
