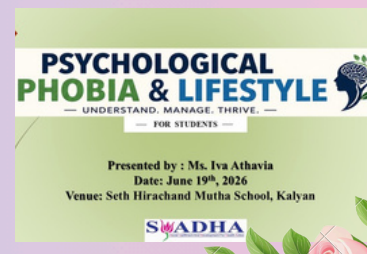
Empowering Young Minds: Session on "Psychological Phobias and Healthy Lifestyle Practices"
